

THE EIFFEL TOWER

When the French government the 1889 Centennial Exposition, to commemorate the French Revolution, the famous engineer Alexandre-Gustave Eiffel was chosen to build a suitable symbolic structure to the happening. The tower he was at Campo de Marte, near the Sena River, and had 984 feet and 7.000 tons.

Gustave Eiffel was a distinguished of steam machines, bridges, railway cars, churches and even railway stations, everything in the remarkable "Belle Époque" style. He also the "Bon Marché" store in Paris, as he was the engineer in charge of providing the structure for the "Liberty Statue" in New York.

The tower was to be by the end of the Exposition, but a great number of people through general manifestations, that the structure should stay at Campo de Marte. That's why it and was used for purposes during the World War I.
